REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION

1. Standard size canvas/paper – 5"x7" to 16"x20".
2. **Due to inclement weather for this year's 1-day event, artists are invited to submit artwork depicting an area in any of Atlantic County's parks during any season.**
3. Artwork entered must be framed and wired, ready for hanging.
4. Two works may be submitted. However space may be limited to one piece (gallery discretion).
5. Work must be picked up at the gallery the week of December 4th.
6. Accepted mediums: oil, watercolor, acrylic, pastel, and drawing.
7. Artists are asked to capture the beauty of the Atlantic County Parks. See map of park locations.

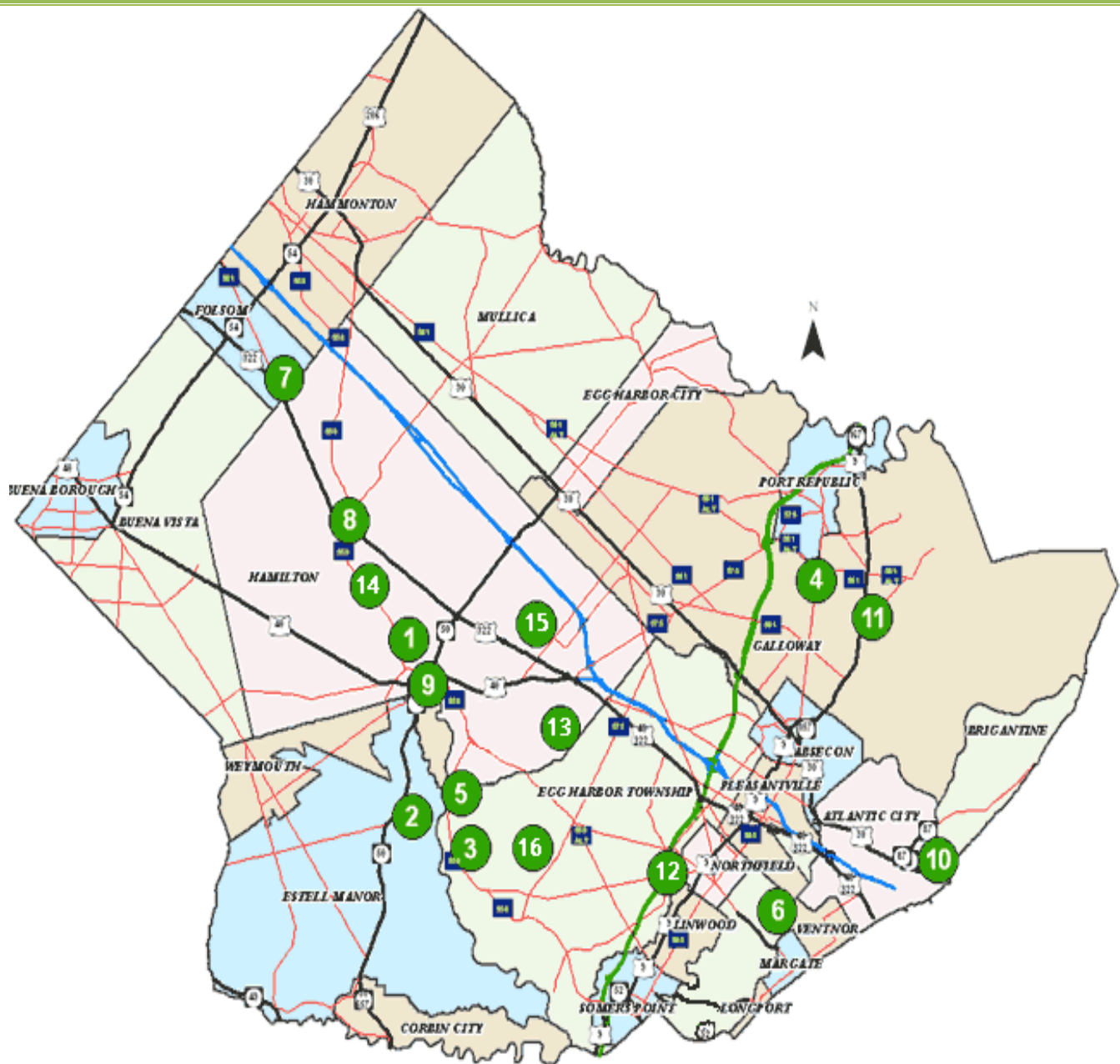
