By Virtue of a deed of Conveyance from Mary Jones by her lawfull attorney Thomas Cadwalader to George West of four thousand five hundred and ninety eight acres three rods & eighteen perches of Unlocated land by deed bearing date the 21<sup>st</sup> day of March A.D. 1812.

In Pursuance thereof I have surveyed for the Said George West the following described tract of Land Situate in the Township of Weymouth, County of Gloucester, and Western Division of New Jersey - bounded as follows viz - Beginning at the mouth of Lewis Island creek on the North side thereof, the chimney on Enoch Lard's house bearing North fifty degrees East, and the store house on said West wharf bears South ten degrees East then (1<sup>st</sup>) South eighty eight & an half degree West twenty four chains & forty links (2<sup>nd</sup>) North nineteen degrees West thirty five chains (3<sup>rd</sup>) North sixty four degrees East two chains (4<sup>th</sup>) North forty degrees West thirty chains & fifty links (5<sup>th</sup>) North eleven degrees West seven chains & fifty links (6<sup>th</sup>) North thirty three degrees West ten chains (7<sup>th</sup>) North one degree West ninety five chains & fifty links (8<sup>th</sup>) North seventy five degrees East forty eight chains (9<sup>th</sup>) South thirty seven chains & twenty five links (10<sup>th</sup>) South twenty degrees East twenty chains (11<sup>th</sup>) South twenty five degrees West twenty two chains & fifty links then (12<sup>th</sup>) North seventy four degrees East two chains & fifty links then (13<sup>th</sup>) South fifty eight degrees East twenty three chains then (14<sup>th</sup>) South eighty six degrees West eleven chains & fifty links then (15<sup>th</sup>) South one & an half degree East fifty seven chains & twenty five links then (16<sup>th</sup>) North Eighty eight & an half degrees East twenty two chains & fifty links then (17<sup>th</sup>) South twenty five degrees West forty chains to the place of beginning, containing 249 acres and allowance exclusive of a part of a Survey made to Charles Sturgeson, & a Survey made to Rudolph Townsend & fifty acres to John Stanaland, and fifty acres made to John English and ten acres to Constant Somers and one hundred and ninety one acres and eighty three hundredths.
